



SAFEGUARDING POLICY.

STATEMENT.

5 on the Farm takes it responsibility to safeguard children, young adults and vulnerable persons very seriously and works to ensure their safety is central to everything they do whether that is at this event or on screen. Both physical and emotional welfare requires safeguarding.

The Management of the event give full backing to this policy and support all those who endeavour to carry out this policy.

PROTECTION FROM HARM.

5 on the Farm fully believe that no person, regardless of age, should come under any form of harm, whether this is physical or emotional.

All activities and facilities on site will be designed to minimise any distress to any of our customers whether that's on account of whether it's physical distress or mental anguish over sexuality, body image, race, gender, age or ethnic background alongside any other reasons. In line with this, all toilet facilities within 5 on the Farm will be gender neutral unless otherwise indicated and within their own sealed units. Additionally, the Milkshake Meadow will have their own designated toilet facilities within this area.

If you see anything suspicious, please do not hesitate to approach or contact any member of staff for assistance.

All key staff members who may be involved in dealing with children, young adults or vulnerable persons in any capacity whether they are activity leaders, artists, welfare staff along with members of the event management team have been DBS checked prior to working at 5 on the Farm.

LOST PERSONS.

5 on the Farm have robust systems in place to deal with lost persons, whether these are children, young adults or vulnerable persons. These systems are designed to deal with these situations in a fast, thorough, safe and discreet fashion.

Upon arrival at site, we encourage you to write a contact number, both a mobile and a landline emergency contact where possible, on your child's wristband provided. It is important that you do not write your child's name on this. In the event you are separated from your child, the contact numbers will be used to reunite you.
